### **Greetings:**

<u>Planners:</u> Parents and Guardians, I have students write in their planners DAILY what the specific homework assignment is for the day. Including Fridays.



If your child does not have or remember their homework, please check the parent portal. I will list the assignment. If the assignment is a work sheet I will have a pdf of the work sheet attached to the title of the assignment. Click on the paperclip icon and the pdf will appear.

Results of the Unit 1 final are in the portal. This is an assessment of all three learning targets and is not an assessment that can be re-taken. If students did not do as well as they had hoped they still have over half the quarter to improve their overall math grade.

Unit 2 starts on Tuesday. This unit is working on multiplication and division with fractional numbers, estimation(adults use this everyday), and order of operations with all fraction operations. There will NOT be learning target quizzes for unit 2; just one final unit assessment. Students should make sure they are reviewing assignments, classmates and updating their bookmarks every night.
