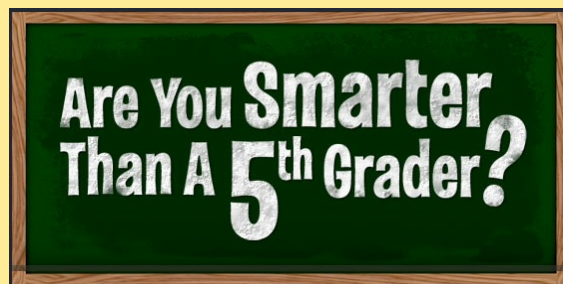
Please note that the 5th grad newsletter will be sent out on Mondays from now on.
