

Mathematics 10/29/18



This week we will conclude how to find the area of parallelograms, triangles, and trapezoids. Students needed a few more days on theses topics to better understand them so the quiz got moved to this Wednesday. The quiz will be go on quarter 2 grade.

Students have done several hands on activities in this unit including using geoboards/rubber bands to find the area of shapes and cutting out, rearranging and glueing shapes to discover why the equations work.

Starting quarter 2, we will have new seats and move into finding the volume and surface area of rectangular prisms.
