UPDATED MPS District Wellness Policy

The MPS Board of Education approved Wellness Policy 6690 at its June 13, 2017 meeting. The updated policy bring us into compliance with federal guidelines regarding student and staff wellness and includes the following requirements: schools must provide unrestricted access to potable water during meal periods for students; all foods offered or sold during the school day must meet Smart Snacks standards; and more. In addition, it requires all elementary schools to provide a cumulative total of 30 minutes of daily recess for students. Building leaders will be responsible for implementing these policies, and there will be ongoing reviews to ensure the district remains in compliance.
